Both the petitions have been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No. 0026 dated 20.04.2017 registered for the offence punishable under Section 307, 341, 427, 506 read with Section 34 of Indian Penal Code and 25, 27 of Arms Act at Police Station Sadar Sangrur, District Sangrur.

Heard.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sarabjit Singh

submits that petitioners have joined the investigation which is still in progress. The recovery has been effected in these cases. The custodial interrogation of petitioners is not required for the purpose of further investigation.

Keeping in view the above but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, both these petitions are allowed and the order dated 01.06.2017 passed in CRM-M-17711-2017 and CRM-M-19558-2017 are made absolute till the presentation of challan, subject to the following terms:-

- (i) that the petitioners shall make themselves available for interrogation by the police as and when required;
- (ii) that the petitioners shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the accusation against them so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- (iii) that the petitioners shall not leave India without the prior permission of the Court.
- (iv) that the petitioners will seek regular bail on the presentation of challan in Court, which the trial Court will decide on the basis of evidence collected during investigation.
