Petitioner seeks concession of regular bail pending trial in FIR No. 117 dated 14.05.2015 under Sections 22/61/85 of NDPS Act registered at Police Station Shimlapuri, District Ludhiana.

As per prosecution version the recovery effected from the petitioner is of 20 injections of 2 ml each of Buprenorphine and 20 injections of 10 ml each of Avil.

The alleged recovery as regards Buprenorphine would be considered as commercial in nature.

In view of the specific bar contained under Section 37 of the NDPS Act, this Court is not inclined to grant concession of regular bail in favour of the petitioner.

The petition is dismissed.
