Heard learned Counsel for the rival parties. The petitioners seek quashing of DDR No.19 dated 2.9.2016, under Sections 452, 323, 427, 506, 34 IPC, PS Daba, District Ludhiana, recorded as cross version in FIR No.149 dated 28.8.2016, under Sections 307, 323, 324, 506, 427, 148, 149 IPC, PS Daba, District Ludhiana on the basis of compounding/compromise. Pursuant to the order dated 18.7.2017, report of the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana has been received who has recorded the statements of the parties and reported that the compromise has been effected voluntarily, without any pressure or coercion. In that view of the matter, the petition is allowed and the impugned DDR as aforesaid, along with all consequential proceedings, is quashed by way of compounding/compromise.
