Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners, namely, Harbans Singh Bolina, Narshare Singh, Gurbax Singh, Sukhvir Singh, Harjot Singh, Gurpreet Singh alias Bunty, Ranjit Singh, Daljit Singh, Jagjit Singh and Arvinder Singh in case registered by way of FIR No.80 dated 19th May, 2015 at Police Station Adampur, Jalandhar under Sections 365, 323, 341, 148, 149 IPC and Section 66 of IT Act, 2000.

That initially the petitioners as is much apparent from the record in this anticipatory bail application were allowed interim bail by this Court vide orders dated 8th May, 2016 and had joined the investigations, which is conceded to at the bar by the learned State Counsel and due to non-appearance, the earlier bail application filed by the

petitioners stood dismissed vide orders dated 20th January, 2017. With all fairness learned State Counsel has conceded that petitioners 09 others, in all 10, have already joined investigation and that nothing is to be recovered and do not oppose the grant of the bail to them.

Since, the custodial interrogation is no more required and it would be travesty of justice to send the petitioners behind the bars in the present case. In view of this, in the event of arrest, petitioners are ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). They shall continue to join investigation and shall furnish an undertaking that they shall abide by the conditions specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.. Thereafter, the petitioners will be permitted to furnish bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
