Learned counsel for the petitioners contended that petitioner No.3 was married to daughter of respondent No.4 on 18.02.2017 according to Hindu rites and ceremonies. Thereafter, wife of petitioner No.3 started behaving indifferently and ultimately, matter was compromised between the parties whereby an amount of Rs.6,50,000/- was agreed to be paid to Preeti @ Purshotam Rani at the time of divorce.

Learned counsel further contended that respondent No.2 is a close confident of husband of respondent No.4 and he has started harassing the petitioners in the aforesaid context.

Precisely for the grievance in question, a representation was filed by the petitioners before the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana vide complaint No.1057944.

The said representation is statedly pending before the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. P.S. Ghuman, Additional A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1.

At this stage, in view of nature of order which this Court proposes to pass, there is no necessity of filing any reply to the petition as no order prejudicial to interest of any of the party is being passed.

This petition is disposed of by directing the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to take notice of pending representation which was addressed to State of Punjab through Home Secretary and decide the same in accordance with law.
