Heard learned Counsel for the rival parties. The petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.149 dated 28.8.2016, under Sections 307, 323, 324, 506, 427, 148, 149 IPC, PS Daba, District Ludhiana on the basis of compounding/compromise. Pursuant to the order dated 19.5.2017, report of the learned JMIC, Ludhiana has been received who has recorded the statements of the parties and reported that the compromise has been effected voluntarily, without any pressure or coercion.
