This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to respondent No. 2 to look into the request of the petitioners (Annexure P-5) and registered a case against the private respondents and to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and their family members which is in danger at the hands of respondents No.4 to 9. With further prayer to direct respondent No.2 to take legal action against respondent No.3 (SHO Police Station Ramdass), District Amritsar who colluded with the private respondents despite having a knowledge of order dated 29.03.2017 passed by this Court in CRM-M-10695 of 2017, pressurized, tortured and misbehaved with the petitioners and their family members to handover the girl (petitioner No.1) to the private respondents and threatened to petitioner No.2 and his family members.

Learned counsel for the petitioners only prays for the relief that the representation dated 10.04.2017 (Annexure P-5), moved to the SSP, Amritsar, by petitioner No.1-Monika, be considered and he does not press

the other relief asked in this petition.

In view of above, respondent No.2-SSP (Rural), Amritsar is directed to look into the said representation (Annexure P-5) and pass appropriate order within one month, as per law, after receiving the certified copy of this order.

With aforesaid direction, this petition stands disposed of.
