After hearing learned counsel for the petitioners and perusal of the records, the petition stands disposed off with direction to the official respondents to ensure that the petitioners are not unduly put to harassment by repeatedly calling them to the Police Station or the office of senior police officers or visiting the house of the petitioners, and in case the petitioners are required in any complaint a clear seven days' notice be given to them to enable them to have their legal recourse.

However, it is made clear that this order shall not come in the way of any recourse to law so adopted by the authorities.
