Learned counsel for petitioners submits that petitioners have filed this petition seeking protection of their lives and liberty alleging that they are major and have married against the wishes of respondents No. 3 and 4, who are parents of petitioner No. 1. He confines the relief claimed in this petition for direction to respondent No. 5 to look into the contents of petition and take appropriate action in accordance with law.

In view of above submission of learned counsel for petitioners, this petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.5-Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh to look into the contents of the petition and take appropriate action in accordance with law, on receipt of copy of this order along with petition.

However, it is made clear that this order will have no effect on the validity of alleged marriage of the petitioners or on any other civil or criminal proceedings instituted against them.
