Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.68 dated 10.03.2017 registered under Sections 379B, 411, 34 IPC at Police Station Sadar Amritsar, Police Commissionerate, District Amritsar.

The allegations are that petitioner along with Chand was recipient of stolen articles. A raid was conducted on the basis of secret information to the effect that Kulwant Singh and Kuldeep Singh are in the habit of selling snatched articles in the market. Kulwant Singh and Kuldeep Singh were arrested in the raid. Petitioner was implicated on the basis of disclosure

statement of co-accused and mobiles were allegedly recovered from him. Similarly situated co-accused Chand has been granted concession of regular bail by this Court vide order dated 12.05.2017 in CRM-M No.16091 of 2017.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Gulshan Lal states that challan has not been presented so far.

Looking to the facts of the case, the same appears to be debatable in the context of alleged recovery on the basis of disclosure statement of the co-accused.

In view of above, at this stage, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Amritsar.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an expression of any opinion on merits of the case.
