Prayer made in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.35 dated 03.03.2017 registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 452, 506 IPC and Section 325 IPC was added later on at Police Station Sahazadpur, District Ambala.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. P.P. Chahar, D.A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Let a copy of the petition be supplied to him during course of the day.

As per allegations in the FIR, Karambir and Aakash @ Akshay (petitioner) were armed with rods and hit the complainant at the back. Pinki and Ram Pyari gave fist blows to the complainant. Complainant was saved by Jaswanti and

Ranjit.

Out of the total accused, Gurnam has already approached this Court by filing **CRM-M No.9433 of 2017** and the said petition has been disposed of today by this Court while granting him concession of anticipatory bail. Another co-accused Karambir has already been granted regular bail by the Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class Naraingarh vide order dated 22.03.2017.

The offence under Section 325 IPC was added on 15.03.2017. In the initial version of the FIR, only offence in terms of Section 452 IPC was non-bailable in nature.

In view of above, petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer to join investigation on 22.05.2017 at 11.00 a.m. and in the event of his appearance, he shall be enlarged on bail, subject to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
