This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for directing the SSP-Amritsar (Rural)-respondent No.2 to ensure that the local police officials do not obstruct/interfere in re-construction of residential house of the petitioner at the instant of private respondents who have lost in civil Court, but have been harassing and humiliating the petitioner and his family through local police because of which the lintel on the raised construction could not be put and the entire building material is lying unattended and the petitioner and his family have no roof on their heads and with further prayer to issue directions to SSP-respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation (Annexure P-6).

Learned counsel for the petitioner only prays for the relief that the representation dated 20.03.2017 (Annexure P-6), moved to the SSP, (Rural) Amritsar, by the petitioner-Surjit Singh, be considered and he does not press the other relief asked in this petition.

In view of above, respondent No.2-SSP (Rural), Amritsar is

directed to look into the said representation (Annexure P-6) and pass

appropriate order within two months, as per law, after receiving the certified copy of this order.

With aforesaid direction, this petition stands disposed of.
