The instant petition has been filed for issuing direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 to take legal action against respondents No. 4 to 9.

In the reply, filed on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3, it is stated that on investigation, the allegations in case FIR No. 42 dated 28.03.2014, registered under Section 376/34 of the Indian Penal Code ('IPC' for short) at Police Station City Jalalabad, District Fazilka were found to be incorrect and cancellation report in this case has been presented.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the reply, the present petition has been rendered infructuous. However, liberty may be afforded to the petitioner to avail the remedies available to him.

Accordingly, this petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous with liberty to the petitioner to avail legal remedies as may be available to him in accordance with law.
