By filing the present petition, under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No.1 dated 08.01.2016, registered under Section 409 of IPC, at Police Station NRI Amritsar, District Amritsar City.

Heard.

Vide order dated 14.06.2016, this Court observed that in case the petitioner failed to deliver the vacant possession of the house in question to the complainant by the adjourned date, the present petition seeking concession of pre-arrest bail shall stand dismissed.

The learned State counsel on instructions states that the order dated 14.06.2016 has not been complied with.

As the petitioner has failed to comply with the order dated 14.06.2016, therefore, no case for anticipatory bail is made out, at this stage.
