This petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking quashing of FIR No. 231 dated 20.05.2015 registered under Section 147, 149, 323, 364, 452, 427, 379 & 506 IPC of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station City Narnaul, District Mahendergarh (Haryana) and all subsequent proceedings.

Respondent No.4 had got the aforesaid FIR registered against the accused persons who are parents of petitioner with the allegation that she was married to the complainant and accused persons have kidnapped her and committed aforesaid offence.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had already made a statement under Section 164 Cr.P.C. before the Magistrate stating that she never got married to the complainant-Naveen and the

allegations levelled by Naveen against her father and brother are false.

Reply by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, City Narnaul, District Mahendergarh has been filed and as per this reply a report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. for commission of offence under Section 147, 149, 323, 252, 427 & 506 IPC has been submitted before the trial Court on 10.03.2015.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Satyawar Singh submit that charges have been framed in the present case.

In view of the fact that while submitting the challan, the police has deleted Section 364 IPC as the petitioner has made a statement under Section 164 Cr.P.C. and also in view of the fact that none of the accused persons has filed the petition seeking quashing of the FIR, this petition is rendered infructuous.

The petition stands disposed of.
