The petitioner has been in detention for over 6 months and 15 days, now, according to the Custody Certificate dated 10.08.2017. It transpires that he is involved in a number of other cases but all are under Section 136 of the Electricity Act. Admittedly no firearm was recovered from him, nor any actual dacoity has taken place even in this case.

For the aforesaid reasons, the petitioner may be released on bail to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Karnal with a further direction to report at his local Police Station once a week during pendency of the trial.
