Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent no. 3, i.e. the Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala, to go into the grievance of the petitioner, in terms of the representation made to him on 30.03.2017, a copy of which has been annexed with the petition as Annexure P-1, and to take a decision thereon within a specified period.

Consequently, without going into the merits of the contentions made in the petition, in any manner whatsoever, respondent no. 3, i.e. the Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala, is directed to go into the matter and to take a decision as per law, on the representation of the petitioner, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
