Prayer in this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case arising out of FIR No.20 dated 05.04.2017 for offence under Section 406, 498-A, 506, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station, Women Police Station, Panchkula.

Learned counsel for the parties submit that the mediation has been failed.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances of the case, interim bail was granted to the petitioner vide order dated 19.05.2017 passed by this Court, is made absolute, subject to the condition that the petitioner shall deposit an F.D. of ₹15 lacs before the trial Court in the name

of the complainant within a period of one month. The petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when required to do so and abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Sections 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The fate of the said F.D.R. will be decided by the trial Court at the final stage of the trial.

Accordingly, the petition stands disposed of.
