The petitioner had filed criminal complaint No. IPC 9333/14/20640009333201 in the Court of Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Chandigarh. The following is the order passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Chandigarh on 05.09.2014:-

“Learned counsel for the complainant suffered a statement for withdrawal of the present complaint without prejudice to the right of the complaint to file fresh complaint before appropriate Court. Hence, in view of his statement, the present complaint is dismissed as withdrawn. File be consigned to the record room.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner Mr. Naresh Kumar Bedi submits that the JMIC, Chandigarh had asked him to withdraw the said complaint and that is why his complaint was withdrawn. He then appears to have approached the Court of Additional Sessions Judge, District Court, Chandigarh who had made an order on 23.02.2015 (Annexure P-1) as no

appeal could lie before this Court against the said order. This is the submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner now states that he wants to withdraw the present petition. He fairly states that there is no pressure from anybody for withdrawing the present petition. Statement is accepted and counsel for the petitioner is allowed to withdraw the present petition.
