Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that three identically placed co-accused have already been admitted to bail by this Court in CRM-M Nos. 11254 of 2017, 12964 of 2017 and 13517 of 2017.

Learned State counsel does not dispute the aforesaid factual position and though two other cases are also seen to be registered against the petitioner, it is not denied by learned State counsel that one of the co-accused, i.e. Gurwinder Singh, was also similarly placed.

In view of the above, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, for or against the petitioner, for the reasons also given in the aforesaid petitions, the petition is allowed. The petitioner shall be admitted to bail upon his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court, during the pendency of the trial.
