The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.62 dated 11.10.2006 under Section 296, 295-A, 323, 324, 506, 148, 149 IPC, Police Station Dhilwan, District Kapurthala in view of compromise.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Learned counsel appearing for complainant submits that compromise has been arrived at between the parties.

This Court had made order dated 22.5.2017 asking for recording of statement in order to find out the correctness and genuineness of the compromise said to have been arrived at between the parties.

Accordingly, statements have been recorded by the trial Court and report has been received by this Court. Looking to the report it is seen

that the compromise is voluntary and genuine. I have seen the offences registered against the petitioner. Looking to the nature of the offence I think the compromise should be allowed.

In view of the above, I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) CRM-M-18037 of 2017 is allowed.
- (ii) FIR No.62 dated 11.10.2006 under Section 296, 295-A, 323, 324, 506, 148, 149 IPC, Police Station Dhilwan, District Kapurthala is quashed, qua the petitioner.
