Petitioner seeks quashing of order dated 08.02.2017 (Annexure P-1) passed by Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Chandigarh whereby he has been declared as absconding/proclaimed person.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that though in CRM-M No.5860 of 2017 decided on 22.02.2017, petitioner was permitted to withdraw the said petition and in the event of his filing application for regular bail before the trial Court and challenging the order dated 09.02.2017, the same was to be decided on the same day in accordance with law.

Learned counsel further submitted that since non-

bailable warrants have already been issued against the petitioner and the petitioner was never served with the process of the Court as per report dated 02.11.2016, therefore, the petitioner felt reasonable apprehension of his arrest.

In the light of order passed on 22.02.2017, no fresh order is required to be passed in the present petition, however, petitioner would be at liberty to surrender before the trial Court and file application for regular bail in terms of the aforesaid order.

Petition stands disposed of.
