Petitioners remained unrepresented on 14.05.2015 as well as on 21.08.2015, when the case was ordered to be adjourned *sine die*. Today also none has appeared on behalf of the petitioners.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI, Jaswant Singh stated that when the present petition was filed, the family members of the petitioners were facing trial for the offences under Sections 302, 336, 148, 149 IPC. Petitioners prayed for protection from harassment at the hands of the police officials. Since the main accused in the FIR have already been acquitted, therefore, there is no threat perception of any harassment at the hands of the police officials.

In view of aforesaid, I find that no further action is called for in the present criminal petition and the same is accordingly dismissed.
