Petitioner-Naval Kishore has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.141 dated 04.04.2017, registered at Police Station Sector 5, Panchkula, District Panchkula, under Sections 341, 342, 385, 452, 467, 468, 469, 471, 506, 511 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested the instant petition.

Complainant has also appeared through his counsel.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned

State counsel and have gone through the record.

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At the time of arguments, it is even admitted by learned counsel for the complainant that parties have effected compromise.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 19.05.2017 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation. He is not required for custodial interrogation. Therefore, no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioner to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details; without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and in view of the fact that compromise has taken place between the parties, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 19.05.2017, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
