The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail in cross case D.D.R. No. 42, dated 24.09.2016, registered under Sections 307/324/341/148/149 of the Indian Penal Code, in case F.I.R. No. 218, dated 23.09.2016, registered under Sections 323/341/506/148/149 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station City Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

2. It is submitted on behalf of Ld. State counsel that while the petitioner has joined investigation, yet he is not cooperative. Weapon of offence/knife allegedly used by him in the occurrence cannot be recovered,

except by way of custodial interrogation.

3. Perusal of the victim's Medico Legal Report indicates that the injury No. 3 was an incised wound, which is clearly attributable to a sharp cutting weapon and, therefore, is in consonance with the victim's statement in the F.I.R.

4. For the aforesaid reasons, this does not appear to be a fit case for grant of anticipatory bail.

5. The petition is, therefore, rejected and the interim bail earlier granted to the petitioner stands cancelled.
