This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., seeking 'regular bail' to the petitioner, in case FIR No.127 dated 10.08.2016, registered for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 364, 302, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, with Sections 115, 216, 216-A, 120-B and 473 IPC added later, registered at Police Station Sadar, Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was not even present at his own farm house a day prior to the shooting or at the other farm house in

which the deceased is stated to have been killed. She submits that the call detail records of the petitioner, available with the investigating agency, bears out the aforesaid contention as the petitioner was found to be in Dalhousie where he had gone to drop his son.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the official who is present in Court to assist him, does not deny the factual position.

Keeping in view the above, I deem it appropriate to admit the petitioner to bail.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed. The petitioner shall be admitted to bail upon his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
