Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been made for quashing F.I.R. No.107 dated 05.05.2015 registered under Sections 447/427/511/506/34 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Sadar, Nakodar, District Jalandhar, on the basis of compromise dated 11.05.2017 (Annexure-P2).

Vide order dated 23.05.2017, the parties were directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate on 02.06.2017, to get their statements recorded for compromise with a direction to the Illaqa Magistrate to furnish a report alongwith the recorded statements qua veracity of the compromise, if any, between the parties.

Consequently, the parties had appeared before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Nakodar on 02.06.2017 and got recorded their statements for compromise and report from the concerned Magistrate has

also been received vide letter bearing No.4586 dated 14.06.2017 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Jalandhar vide Endst. No.1488/JRK dated 16.06.2017.

According to the report of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Nakodar, the compromise arrived at between the parties is volunteer.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the present petition is accepted and the aforesaid F.I.R. No.107, is hereby quashed qua the petitioner.
