This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of direction to Director General of Police, Punjab, Senior Superintendent of Police, Sri Muktsar Sahib and SHO, Police Station Kot Bhai, District Sri Muktsar Sahib arrayed as respondents No.2 to 4 in

the present case to ensure protection of lives and liberty of the petitioners and their family members at the hands of private respondents arrayed as respondents No.6 to 15, respectively for the reason that petitioner Jagroop Singh had appeared as a witness against them in criminal case trial bearing No.SC-54 of 2012 instituted on 11.9.2012/4.10.2014 decided on 10.9.2015.

It is stated that the petitioners have approached the police authorities making representations against private respondents for taking necessary action in the matter but no action has been taken in the matter so far.

Heard.

This petition is disposed of directing Senior Superintendent of Police, Sri Muktsar Sahib (respondent No.3) to look into the grievances of petitioners as contained in the representation and to take suitable action, if so warranted, within two months.
