The petitioner is seeking quashing of FIR No.626 dated 07.12.2014 under Sections 323, 506, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Mahendergarh, District Mahendergarh (Annexure P-1), on the basis of compromise between the parties dated 01.05.2017 (Annexure P-2).

A coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 19.05.2017 had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate for recording their statements with regard to the veracity of the compromise. The Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate has sent her report dated 30.05.2017 wherein it is

stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, statements of the parties were recorded. As per the statements of the parties, the compromise has been effected without any fear or undue influence.

The FIR is the outcome of a dispute between the family members who have now resolved the matter and want to live peacefully.

In view of the law laid down in **Narinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab 2014 (6) SCC 466**, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No.626 dated 07.12.2014 under Sections 323, 506, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Mahendergarh, District Mahendergarh and all consequential proceedings are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
