The instant petition was preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for issuance of directions to the official respondents to hand over the investigation pertaining to FIR No.132, dated 13.06.2016, under Sections 407/420 IPC, registered at Police Station Kaithal to an officer not below the rank of Superintendent of Police or to any other independent agency.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that after issuance of notice of motion in the instant petition, a response by way of affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Guhla, District Kaithal has been placed on record.

Mr. Bansal, learned counsel appearing for the petitioners would make a statement that in the light of the stand taken in para 4 of the reply, he would not be pressing the instant petition.

Petition, accordingly, is disposed of as not pressed.
