Through this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, prayer has been made for quashing F.I.R. No.59 dated 04.10.2015 under Sections 380, 411 and 120-B I.P.C. pertaining to Police Station Sandaur, District Sangrur, on the basis of compromise dated 25.04.2017 (Annexure P-1).

On presentation of the petition, vide order dated 22.05.2017, parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/ Illaqa Magistrate to get their statements recorded for compromise with a direction to the trial Court/ Illaqa Magistrate to furnish a report alongwith the recorded statements qua veracity of the compromise, if any, between the parties.

Consequently, the parties appeared before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Malerkotla on 14.06.2017 and got recorded their

statements for compromise. Report bearing No.208 dated 15.06.2017 from the concerned Magistrate duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Sangrur vide Endorsement No.4090/ES dated 19.06.2017 has also been received.

According to the report of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Malerkotla, the compromise between the parties is genuine, voluntary, without any coercion or greed.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the aforesaid F.I.R. No.59 qua the petitioners, is hereby quashed.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
