The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.107 dated 28.04.2017 registered under Sections 307, 34, 120-B IPC; Section 3 of SC & ST Act and Section 25 of the Arms Act at Police Station Julana, District Jind.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

The petitioner was granted interim bail by this court vide order dated 22.05.2017.

Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custody is not required.

Learned senior counsel for the petitioner makes a statement that the petitioner will file an undertaking that he would not indulge in any type of offence and would also submit a copy of the affidavit to the concerned Police Station.

In view of the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is ready to give undertaking on affidavit as stated above, I am inclined to make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) Interim order dated 22.05.2017 is made absolute.
- (ii) The CRL. MISC. No.M-18157 OF 2017 is allowed, subject to following conditions.
- (iii) The petitioner shall file an affidavit within two weeks from today that he will not commit any type of offence again and would also submit a copy of the affidavit to the concerned Police Station as aforesaid.
- (iv) The petitioner shall report to the police station concerned on every Monday, Wednesday, Friday and Sunday between 11.00am to 4.00pm.
