This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.165 dated 24.8.2016 under sections 395, 452, 342, 120-B, 411 I.P.C read with sections 25, 27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station, Model Town, Ludhiana, district Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the parties have been heard.

FIR came to be registered on the statement of Pankaj Agnihotri on the allegations that on 24.8.2016 while he was away to his place of business of Electronics, he received a telephonic call at about 12.20 P.M from his mother namely Pushpa Agnihotri that six unidentified persons, who were armed with pistols and revolvers entered the gate of the house after having put the guard Budh Ram under fear of firearms and thereafter ransacked the house and took away Rs.12 lacs cash and 2 kgs of jewelry.

Present petitioner was arrested on 18.12.2016 on the basis of a secret information received by the investigating agency as regards the petitioner being present in a park close to the vicinity of the place of occurrence and as such, being part of the conspiracy for carrying out the

offence.

Challan in the case has already been presented. Charges are yet to be framed.

Co-accused Kartar Singh and Inderjeet Singh and who were implicated on the basis of a supplementary statement recorded of the complainant on 30.12.2016 have been granted benefit of bail by this Court.

Petitioner, otherwise, is stated to be having clean antecedents. The trial is at the very initial stage and would take time to conclude.

Without making any observations on merits, present petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Ludhiana.

Petition disposed of.
