By filing the present petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought regular bail in case FIR No.06 dated 17.08.2016, registered under Section 148 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'the IPC') read with Section 149 IPC and Section 307 IPC (added later on) and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, at Police Station State Special Operation Cell, Amritsar.

Contents that the petitioner is neither named in the FIR nor any recovery has been effected from him. The FIR was registered on secret information regarding the clash of rival parties. Allegedly there was cross fire between the parties, however, no person sustained injury. Co-accused, Harmandeep Singh, who is named in the FIR, has been enlarged on bail.

The petitioner is likewise implicated in two more FIRs, however, he is on bail in those cases.

Custody certificate has been filed in the Court, same is taken on record.

The learned State counsel has vehemently opposed the present petition.

Heard.

Considering the fact that neither any recovery was effected from the petitioner nor he was named in the FIR and co-accused, Harmandeep Singh, who named in the FIR, has been admitted to bail by this Court, no purpose would be served in keeping the petitioner behind the bars, without adverting to the merits of the instant case, this petition is allowed. The petitioner be admitted to bail during the pendency of the trial, on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds, to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
