The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.134 dated 2.8.2015 under sections 302, 364, 452, 147, 148 I.P.C, registered at Police Station, Ateli, District Mahendergarh.

Learned counsel for the parties have been heard.

Deceased in the present case is Ashok Kumar. Allegations against the present petitioner as also co-accused are that Ashok Kumar (since deceased) was kidnapped and taken away in a Scorpio vehicle and his body was recovered two days thereafter.

Subhash Chand and Nirma i.e. father and wife of the deceased are yet to be examined. They would be construed as material witnesses.

The prayer for grant of bail, at this stage, as such, is declined.

Petition is dismissed.
