In pursuance to the order dated 26.05.2017, respondent No.2 Ashu Gupta, who is present in person and duly identified by ASI Mahesh Kumar has admitted the fact that ₹20 lakhs has already been paid to him by the petitioner. The petitioner is not required for further investigation.

The petition is disposed of and the order dated 19.05.2017 granting the interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute on the following conditions Section 438 Cr.P.C.:-

- i. a condition that the person shall make themselves available for interrogation by Police Officer as and when required;*
- ii. a condition that the persons shall not, directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;*
- iii. a condition that the persons shall not leave India without the previous permission of the Court*
- iv. such other condition as may be imposed under sub section (3) of Section 437, as if the bail were granted under that section.*
