RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J.(Oral)

The petitioner is declared a proclaimed offender vide order dated 4.5.2017 in FIR No.341, dated 18.10.2011 registered under Sections 22/61/85 of NDPS Act at Police Station Payal, Ludhiana. This has resulted from non-appearance on 1.4.2015. Thereafter he again failed to appear on 2.12.2016. The petitioner applied for anticipatory bail which has been rejected on 8.12.2016 by the Sessions Court.

Mr. Pathak informs the Court that order under Section 299 Cr.P.c has been passed on 4.5.2017.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner's wife died in 2015.

Since the petitioner has to take care of children all by himself, it will serve no useful purpose to keep him in the status of proclaimed offender, therefore, it is directed that he would appear before the trial Court on the next date of hearing and the trial Court would consider his bail application in accordance with law on the same date and on such terms as it thinks fixed to

impose.

With these directions, the petition stands disposed of.
