Pursuant to the order dated 25.5.2017, Mr.Mehta, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Mohan Singh, submits that on the date that the petitioner did not appear before the trial Court, leading to the forfeiture of his bail bonds, he was in custody in connection with another FIR registered against him.

Keeping in view the fact that it was not the fault of the petitioner that he was not produced in the Court on the date that he was summoned in connection with the FIR in

question, the petitioner already having been admitted to bail under the provisions of Section 167(2) CrPC earlier, he is ordered to be admitted to bail again, on furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
