The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.117 dated 12.06.2015 registered under Section 380, 342, 397, 457, 412 & 120-B IPC at Police Station Sahnewal, District Ludhiana.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

In this FIR the petitioner was granted bail by the trial Court and was on bail. However, he then absented himself and was declared proclaimed offender on 20.10.2016.

In view of the fact that the learned counsel for the State submits that there is no other case against the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Learned State counsel further submits that two and half quintal copper wire was stolen but that was recovered.

In that view of the matter, I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) The CRL. MISC. No.M-18293 OF 2017 is allowed.

- (ii) The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the concerned CJM/Duty Magistrate, subject to deposited of ₹10,000/- as non-refundable costs with the trial Court as a pre-condition.
- (iii) The petitioner shall report to the police station concerned on every Monday, Wednesday and Sunday from 11.00am to 4.00pm in addition to appearing before the trial Court on the dates fixed.
- (iv) The petitioner shall give undertaking to the police that he will not indulge in such type of offence in future.
- (v) In case of violation of the above condition on the part of the petitioner, the liberty is reserved in favour of the State to apply for cancellation of bail.
