**ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)**

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 202 dated 22.04.2017 under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Amritsar City, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends the petitioner is 74 years old lady whose heart stress test shows that she is at moderate risk. It is further submitted that she was a bona fide purchaser from Mukhtiar Singh, who had allegedly made a power of attorney of the land in question by impersonating Tej Kaur.

A coordinate Bench of this court, by the order dated 22.05.2017, had directed the petitioner to join investigation and in the event of his arrest, she was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the

conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Kulwant Singh, states that in pursuance to the order dated 22.05.2017, the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 22.05.2017, granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
