Petitioner-Sukardin has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.36 dated 26.04.2017, registered at Police Station Kathgarh, District Saheed Bhagat Singh Nagar, under Section 379-B IPC.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the FIR, complainant-Ashok Kumar was going on his Activa Scooter to village Mandera from his house. On 01.04.2017, at about 8.40 P.M., two young persons, who were riding on motor-cycle, stopped him and his wallet containing ₹9200/-, ID cards, Adhar Card, SBI Gold Card, ATM card of PNB Bank, Voter card, Pan Card and cheque of SBI amounting to ₹6,000/- on which his signatures were

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there and one mobile phone, were taken away by them and thereafter they ran away. As per the impugned order, the cheque was later on got encashed by Yusuf and on inquiry, it was found that the same was given by the present petitioner to him.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case, I find that the petitioner is required for custodial interrogation. Otherwise also, no ground is made out for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
