Learned counsel for the petitioner draws attention to the interim orders passed by the trial Court starting from 28.10.2015, showing that the witnesses for the respondent-accused have not been appearing despite non-bailable warrants having been issued from time to time in respect of at least one particular witness.

Learned counsel further submits that the trial Court, however, is not actually proceeding with the case at all, despite about 20 opportunities having been granted to the accused to lead defence evidence.

In the aforesaid situation, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court to positively conclude the trial within three months, it having been pending since the year 2014, with defence witnesses not appearing on various dates between 2015 till now.
