Petitioner seeks the concession of anticipatory bail in FIR No.305 dated 04.11.2016, under Section 406, 498-A and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station City Khanna, District Ludhiana, Punjab.

It is informed that during the pendency of this petition, the matter has been amicably resolved between the parties. Petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, has been filed. Statements of the parties at first motion have been recorded. Part of the settled amount i.e. ₹2,50,000/- has been handed over to respondent no.2. Petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 is now listed for hearing on 18.02.2018. The balance amount shall be handed over to respondent no.2 at the time of recording of statement of the parties at second motion. Petitioner undertakes to abide by the terms and conditions

of the settlement. It is thus, prayed that this petition be allowed.

Learned counsel for respondent no.2 affirms and verifies the settlement between the parties. It is submitted that respondent no.2 has no objection in case this petition is allowed subject to the petitioner adhering to the terms and condition of the settlement. Respondent no.2 undertakes to perform her part of the settlement.

Learned counsel for the State on instructions from ASI Shamsheer Singh, verifies that the petitioner is not involved in any other criminal case and his custodial interrogation is not required.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances as above, specifically the settlement arrived at between the parties, but without commenting upon or expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed. In the event of arrest of the petitioner, he be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting/investigating Officer. Petitioner shall comply with the conditions as stipulated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
