This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.126 dated 12.07.2016, under Sections 363, 366-A, 342, 120-B, 216 IPC and Section 6 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act (added later on), registered at Police Station, Chhainsa, Faridabad.

The petitioner is in custody since 17.02.2017.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, has informed that after investigation, it has been found that the main role has been attributed to the other accused namely Roop Chand, Chamela etc. The role attributed to the present petitioner is that he had conspired with all of them in kidnapping the prosecutrix. She has further informed that after presentation of challan, charges have been framed on 19.10.2016 and out of 14 prosecution witnesses, one has been examined.

Keeping in view the period of incarceration of the petitioner and the fact that trial may take some time for its conclusion, this Court feels that

there is no need to detain the petitioner any longer. Accordingly, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on regular bail on furnishing of bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate, Faridabad.
