ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking quashing of FIR No.53 dated 19.04.2014 under Sections 307/341/323/427/506/148/149 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Ludhiana, District Ludhiana City (Annexure P-1), on the basis of compromise dated 17.05.2014 (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that there is only one injury on the person of complainant and that too, on the non-vital part of the body. It is further contended that FIR is the outcome of misunderstanding between the college students which has now been resolved.

Learned counsel for respondents No.3 to 5 also contends that the matter has indeed been compromised between the parties.

A co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 30.09.2016 had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court for recording their statements with regard to the veracity of compromise. The Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana, has sent her report dated 18.01.2017, wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, statements of the parties were recorded. As per the statements, compromise has been effected without any fear or undue influence.

In view of the law laid down in "**Narinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab**" 2014 (6) SCC 466, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No.53 dated 19.04.2014 under Sections 307/341/323/427/506/148/149 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Ludhiana, District Ludhiana City and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioners only.
