Through this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, prayer has been made for quashing F.I.R. No.73 dated 04.08.2016 registered under Sections 406 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Phase-8, SAS Nagar (Mohali), on the basis of compromise dated 08.03.2017 (Annexure-P2).

On presentation of the petition, vide order dated 22.05.2017 passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioners as also respondents No.2 and 3 were directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate on 31.05.2017 to get their statements recorded for compromise with a direction to the Illaqa Magistrate to furnish a report alongwith the recorded statements qua veracity of the compromise, if any, between the parties.

Consequently, the parties had appeared before the Judicial

Magistrate Ist Class, Mohali on 01.06.2017 and got recorded their

statements for compromise and report from the concerned Magistrate has also been received vide letter bearing No.306 dated 25.07.2017 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, SAS Nagar vide Endst. No.6716 dated 25.07.2017.

According to the report of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Mohali, the compromise between the parties is genuine and has been effected voluntarily, without any pressure, coercion or undue influence.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the present petition is accepted and the aforesaid F.I.R. No.73, is hereby quashed qua the petitioners only.
