Petitioner-Kuldeep Singh has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.131 dated 14.04.2017, registered at Police Station Madhuban, District Karnal, under Sections 307, 323 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared on behalf of respondent-State and complainant also appeared through her counsel.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that FIR, in the present case, has been got registered by Sunita-wife of the petitioner. Perusal of the FIR shows that there is a matrimonial dispute between the parties. As per the allegations, the petitioner thrown the complainant from second floor on the tin-shed which is constructed on the first floor. The complainant has received only simple injuries.

The petitioner has been in custody since 15.04.2017. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
