Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

In view of the order dated 23.01.2017 passed by the Apex
Court in Crl. M. P. No.931/2017 titled as Narender Kumar Khanna Versus
State of Punjab, which reads thus:-

“Delay condoned.

The special leave petition is dismissed.

*However, trial may be expedited and concluded at
the earliest possible.*

*As a sequel to the above, pending interlocutory
applications, if stand disposed of.”*

The issue about the request of the petitioner to go abroad for
the present, does not survive. In addition, learned counsel for the State

submits that out of 11 witnesses 01 witness has been examined who have been given up and the remaining witnesses have been summoned for 18.05.2017. In that view of the matter, in view of the aforesaid Apex Court's order and for the reasons above the present petition is disposed of.

The petitioner may request for the relief that was claimed at the appropriate stage i.e. after acquittal or conviction.
