The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.276 dated 17.08.2016 registered under Sections 302, 436 and 506 IPC read with Section 34 IPC at Police Station Sadar Gohana, District Sonapat.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties at length.

Perused the FSL report, which discloses no traces of kerosene or any other inflammable material. The prosecution case is that the deceased was burnt by the petitioner and her sister.

In the light of the fact that nothing incriminating has been found in the FSL report and further fact that there is no other case reported against the petitioner, I am inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

Hence, I make the following order:

ORDER

(i) CRL. MISC. No.M-1849 OF 2017 is allowed.

(ii) The petitioner be released on bail to the satisfaction of the concerned CJM/Duty Magistrate.
