The instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for issuance of direction to the official respondents to take appropriate legal action against the private respondents and also to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and her daughters at the hands of the private respondents.

Learned counsel contends that she shall be satisfied if respondent No.3, Senior Superintendent of Police, Ludhiana (Rural) is directed to decide her application dated 17.4.2017 (Annexure P-1), in a time bound manner.

At the asking of the Court, Mr.AS Gill, Sr.DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

In the circumstances, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, respondent No.3- Senior Superintendent of Police, Ludhiana (Rural), is directed to decide the application dated 17.4.2017 (Annexure P-1), moved by the petitioner, by passing a speaking order within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.
